II. School updates from Ms. Williams

Three weeks remain for this year! Ms. Williams expressed her gratitude for the PTA for their support and smiles. We have 27 kindergarten students registered, three kinder sections, with size ranges up to 24. The sooner families registered, the sooner the administration can staff it. The new kinder orientation around the district is new, and Ms. Anderson and Ms. Foster have been doing this and will continue to do so.

Staffing: there will be two sections for each grade, except third grade. Third grade will have three sections.

As it stands now: 16 classroom teachers, SPED teacher, .25 ESL teacher, School Psych, Speech, OT (part time), 8 Para-educator, 2 Educational Assistants; Library Assistant, PE, Media/ Library, Visual Arts, Spanish, Yoga/ Movement, IB Coordinator, Math Instructional Coach, Assistant Principal, Front office staff.

Being in person has been amazing! The smaller cohorts are great to see smaller classes. We do miss colleagues. There isn't much interaction, except for the math grant class. The students are making good progress, and they are having strong social connections and school connections—they miss their teacher when they are gone. It brought to light how significant it is to have smaller class size.

V. Sabin PTA Budget 2021-2022 (10)

 The budget was proposed with the reduced fundraising ability, there are some shortfalls--reduction in allocations. There was a line added for Fifth grade graduation.

There was a motion to approve, and the vote was taken and the budget was adopted.

- Sabin Foundation update and fundraising for staffing for next year: the goal is 40,000, we'll probably net \$35,000, will fill in the gaps for secretary and staff "gaps" in funding, There are "matching" donations that are making a difference. Ms. Lori sends out the information for donations. Sabin Community Association is also helping to get the word out--one more week!
- Student Leadership Bid-off was successful for yearbooks, books will be available for all who need. The yearbook is being finished, and it will be available to purchase. Stay tuned.
- End of year/ graduation plans (AKA 5th grade promotion): June 10th at 3pm!
 Teachers and Sonja Williams are organizing a parade walk and under balloon
 arch and parade walk. Outdoors and socially distanced. Information coming out
 soon. The ultimate total: \$900. The funds will be collected by Sonja. The balloon
 is covered by PTA. Fifth grade teachers want some support to make a slide show
 for each class.
- There is some money left in from the end of year celebration to help cover the Fifth grade promotion. There are funds from Student Leadership for that as well.
- Sabin gear sale will happen, maybe we'll have to push it until the fall.
